Final project for EDTC 4236/4237 (Choose one of the four options)

1. Create your own video tip for teachers. Here are some examples:

(please note: there are students visible in these tips. You would need to have parental permission to show the children in your video)

2. Find a grant to apply for technology for your school currently.

Work with a group of your peers to take apart the questions and each of you only has to write part of the grant. You will present to our class the grant requirements and the specifications of how you would apply the grant in the classroom. (Example: writing a grant to receive heart rate monitors).

3. Present a technology lesson that worked with your students this quarter. Show how you assessed their work.
4. Create a multimedia project with your students. Show this to our class. You may need permission as well for this but it may just include student work (not faces) so permission is not necessary.
